

Sightseeing Attraction 1 JR Meisho Line

JR Meisho Line came back to life in 2016 after six and a half years' absence! This scenic slow local railway runs between Matsusaka and Misugi along the Kumozu River in an hour and half. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of rice fields and the river from the train window.



Sightseeing Attraction 2 Rental Bicycles (with electric assist)

Feel the breeze in Misugi on the free rental bicycles and visit the beautiful historic places such as Tage-Kitabatakeshi-Jokan or Wakamiya-Hachimangu Shrine. For sakura (cherry blossom) fans, Mitake-no-sakura, which is one of the best 100 sakura spots in Japan, can't be missed in spring. Taro area also has locations which are thought to be flowing a mystical energy, such as Hikawa-Sekibutsugun Stone Budda Statues or Thirteen-storey pagoda.



Sightseeing Spot in Misugi Tage-Kitabatakeshi-Jokan

Tage-Kitabatakeshi-Jokan, which is one of the next 100 great castles in Japan, is definitely worth visiting. Kitabatakeshi-Yakataato-Teien is a gorgeous Japanese garden with a pond in the center of this huge district. Kitabatake Shrine was also built in the district during the Edo period.

Sightseeing Spot in Misugi² Amago Fish Dishes in Kawakami

Amago fish, which is called "the queen of freshwater fish", lives in the rivers in Tsu city from long ago. Amago's bodies reflect the environment of where they live and those in Misugi are said to be one of the most beautiful ones in Japan. Come and taste various Amago fish dishes in Kawakami area in Misugi.
