Please take this opportunity to undergo cancer screenings

Tsu City will be offering cancer screenings to all residents between July 2019 and March 2020.

To receive these screenings, you need to present a "Cancer Screening Coupon." If you do not have this coupon, please visit one of the health centers listed on the reverse side and apply to have it issued to you.

(Details are provided in the pamphlet "Reiwa Year 1 Guide to Cancer Screenings and Health Examinations" that was distributed at the same time as the June 16 issue of Public Relations Tsu.

How to receive cancer screenings

Decide on the screenings you wish to receive (see reverse side) and select to receive it individually or as a group.

Individual screenings

Individual screenings can be received at cooperating medical institutions in the city.

Select a medical institution from the list provided in the pamphlet "Tsu City Guide to Cancer Screenings and Medical Examinations" and on the Tsu City website.

Group screenings

Group screenings can be received at screening facilities and health centers in the city.

Select a date/time and venue from the calendar provided in the pamphlet "Tsu City Guide to Cancer Screenings and Medical Examinations" and on the Tsu City website.

Make an appointment

Make an appointment with the medical institution you have selected.

Make an appointment with the screening facility you have selected, by phone. When doing so, please have your screening coupon on hand.

You will receive a confirmation letter by no later than three days prior to your date of screening.

Screening

Stay in good physical condition and receive the screenings on your appointment day.

What to bring with you

- 1. Cancer Screening Coupon (please note that this not a free coupon)
- 2. Screening fee *If you are exempt from the payment of screening fee, please bring a document of proof
- 3. Heath insurance card
- 4. Health notebook (if you have one)


